† DIVINE MERCY NOVENA

Beginning Good Friday

By this Novena (of Chaplets), I will grant every possible grace to souls (Diary, 796). I desire that during these nine days you

bring souls to the fountain of My mercy, that they may draw therefrom strength and refreshment and whatever grace they have need of in the hardships of life, and especially at the hour of death (Diary, 1209).

Opening Prayer (optional): You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us (Diary, 1319). O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You! (three times) (Diary, 84).

For each of the nine days, our Lord gave Saint Faustina a different intention:

Day 1: All mankind, especially sinners

Day 2: The souls of priests and religious

Day 3: All devout and faithful souls

Day 4: Those who do not believe in God and those who do not yet know Jesus

Day 5: The souls who have separated themselves from the Church

Day 6: The meek and humble souls and the souls of little children

Day 7: The souls who especially venerate and glorify His mercy

Day 8: The souls detained in purgatory

Day 9: Souls who have become lukewarm (Dairy, 1210-1229)

Pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy.

Closing Prayer (optional): Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless, and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us, and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments, we might not despair, nor become despondent, but with great confidence, submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy Itself. Amen (Diary, 950).

† CHAPLET OF DIVINE MERCY

Through the Chaplet you will obtain everything, if what you ask for will be compatible with My will

(Diary, 1731). Even if a sinner were most

hardened, if only once he will recite this Chaplet, he will obtain grace from My infinite mercy (Diary, 687). At the hour of their death, I defend as My own glory every soul that will say this chaplet; or when others say it for a dying person, the pardon is the same (Diary, 811).

Using a rosary, pray the Chaplet in the following manner:

- 1. Begin with the Sign of the Cross, 1 Our Father, 1 Hail Mary and The Apostles Creed.
- 2. Then, on the Our Father beads, say: Eternal Father, I offer You the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your dearly beloved Son, Our Lord Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
- 3. On the 10 Hail Mary beads, say: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (Repeat step 2 and 3 for all five decades).
- 4. Conclude with: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world. (repeat three times)
