October is Respect Life month! This Sunday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>, from 2:30 pm to 3:30 pm we will have a Life Chain at Daffin Park along Victory Drive. Please come and pray, hold a sign, and witness to the dignity of life with so many others around the country that day and time! Next Sunday, October 10<sup>th</sup>, at 4pm at Blessed Sacrament, there will be a Rosary Coast-to-Coast prayer held for an end to abortion and other offenses against human life.

We hold fast to the beauty and dignity of every human life. We teach and preach it. Do we also model it in our lives? Do we care for the mothers who are tempted and counseled to have an abortion? Do we take them into our homes and under our care? Are our marriages open to life by practicing Natural Family Planning or are we using contraception or have we had our tubes tied or had a vasectomy? 


#### **IMMACULÉE**


