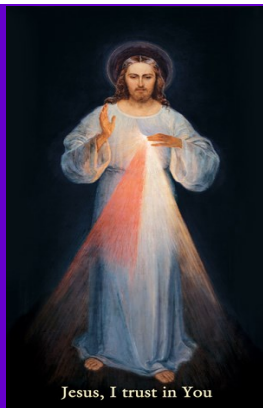

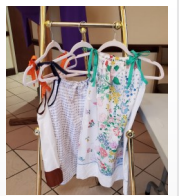

The Diocese of Savannah is seeking a summer intern for a 10-week assignment within the Catholic Campaign for Human Development (CCHD) program. This is a grant-funded position for the duration of June – August 2022.

Intern will work with the CCHD Diocesan Director at the Catholic Pastoral Center in Savannah promoting and overseeing CCHD projects to include community and parish outreach. Applicants must be a Catholic in good standing and over the age of 18 seeking professional opportunities in social ministry fields, community and economic development.

Some travel is required as well as occasional evening and weekend work. Applicants must possess a valid drivers' license and pass a background check. The internship pays \$14 an hour and includes a three-day all expenses paid training with the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) in Washington D.C. Applications are due no later than March 31st.
