**SEPTEMBER 24 & 25**

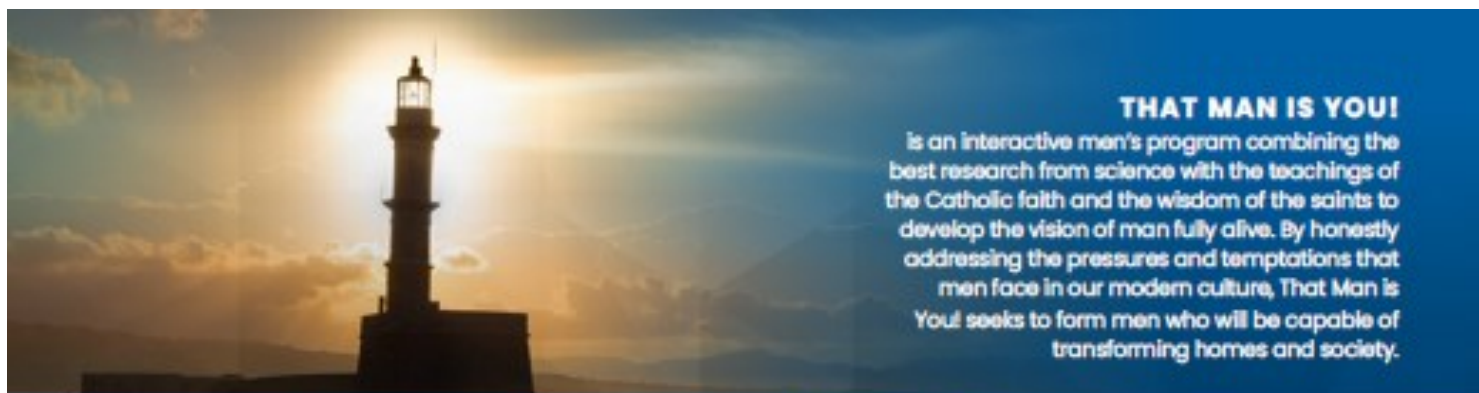
