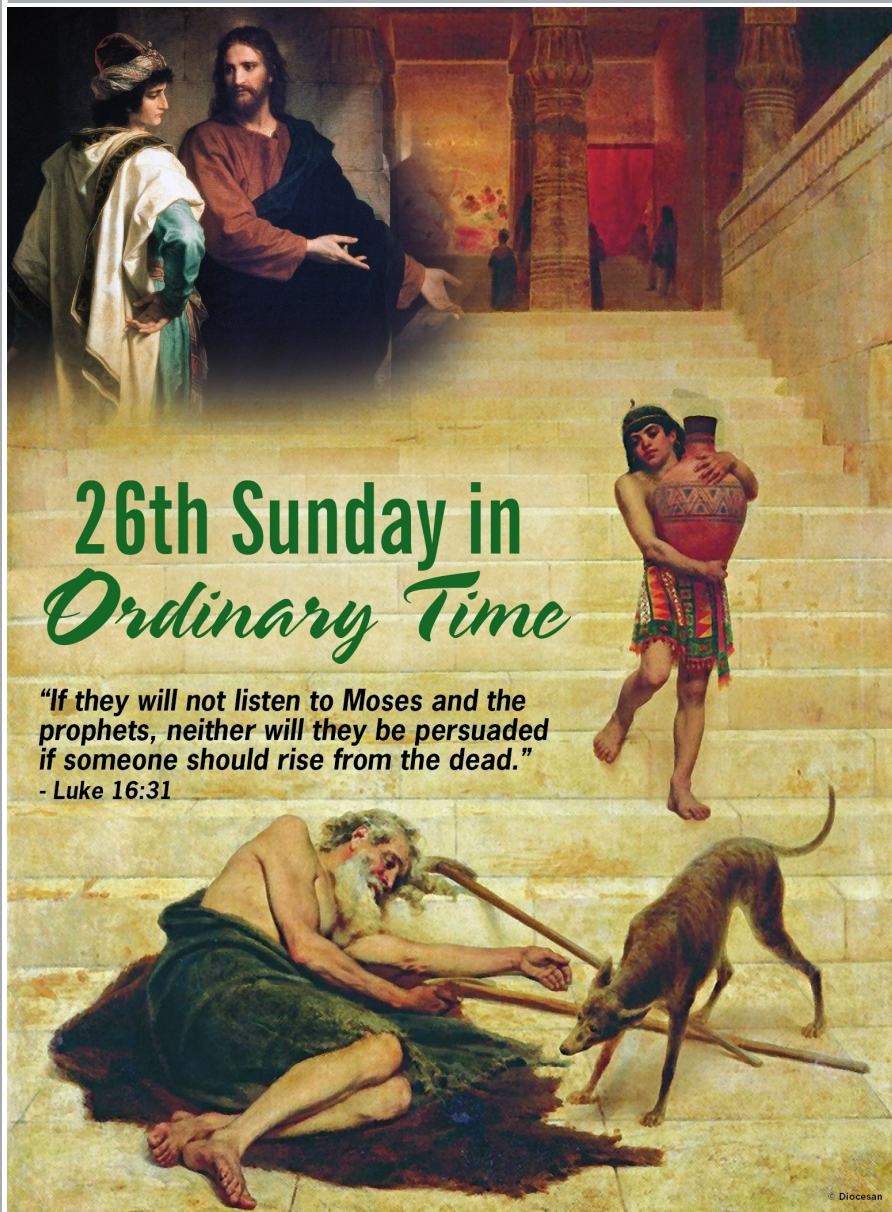

This was founded in 1835 by St. Vincent Pallotti, a Roman diocesan Priest to revive faith and rekindle charity among all and he called everyone to be an apostle of God's love and mercy. "Love of Christ urges us all" was his motto. The Pallottines work mostly in mission countries and the Pallottines in Milwaukee, WI, support the missions in India and Zambia, Africa. They bring the good news of God's love and salvation to the poor people in remote interior areas where there are no modern facilities by providing them the basic necessities of life as well as educating poor children in the villages as they share the Gospel of Christ. They run several parishes, boarding schools, orphanages, Clinics, technical institutes, self-employment programs for poor women in the villages as well as do various other socio- charitable works for the poor and needy. Their missions in India and Zambia are really growing and there is so much need in these missions and your generosity however small can make a difference to these people and bring them much hope and joy. You too can be an apostle!

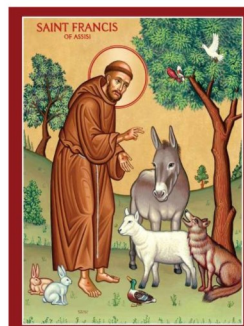

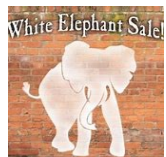
