Fasting and Abstinence

Ash Wednesday, February 22 and Good Friday, April 7, are days of fasting and abstinence. If you are age 18-59, you must fast and abstain. If you are over the age of 14, but not yet 18, you are only required to abstain from eating meat on that day.

A fast means that you can have one meal during the day. You can have two other small meals, but they cannot equal the one meal.

To abstain from meat, means no meat all day. Everyone should abstain from meat on every Friday of Lent. In fact, every Catholic should abstain from meat on every Friday of the year unless you do another penance or work of charity (Canon 1251). Yes, we should all still be abstaining from meat every Friday. That is the default Friday penance.

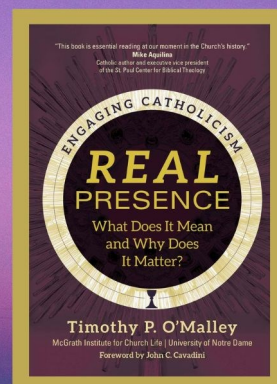

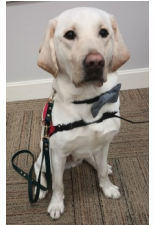

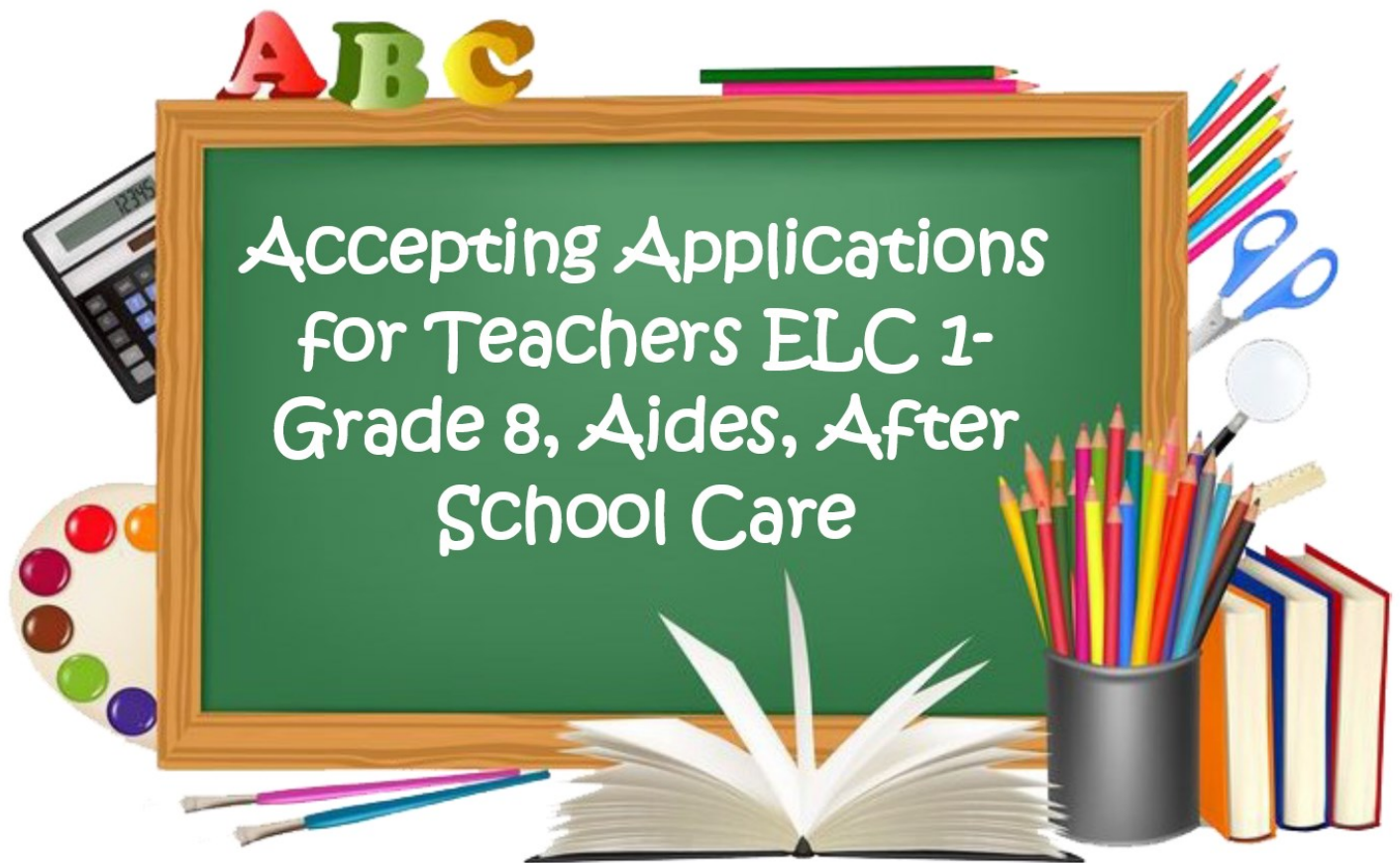
