

+ST.FAUSTINA'S PRAYER TO BE MERCIFUL

O Lord, I want to be completely transformed into Your mercy and to be Your living reflection. May the greatest of all divine attributes, that of Your unfathomable mercy, pass through my heart and soul to my neighbor.

- **† Help me, O Lord,** that my eyes may be merciful, so that I may never suspect or judge from appearances, but look for what is beautiful in my neighbors' souls and come to their rescue.
- **† Help me, O Lord**, that my ears may be merciful, so that I may give heed to my neighbors' needs and not be indifferent to their pains and moanings.
- **† Help me, O Lord,** that my tongue may be merciful, so that I should never speak negatively of my neighbor, but have a word of comfort and forgiveness for all.
- † **Help me, O Lord,** that my hands may be merciful and filled with good deeds, so that I may do only good to my neighbors and take upon myself the more difficult and toilsome tasks.
- **† Help me, O Lord,** that my feet may be merciful, so that I may hurry to assist my neighbor, overcoming my own fatigue and weariness.
- **† Help me, O Lord,** that my heart may be merciful so that I myself may feel all the sufferings of my neighbor. May Your mercy, O Lord, rest upon me. AMEN. (*Diary*, 163).

The Promise of Divine Mercy

Regarding the Feast of Divine Mercy, Our Lord said to Saint Faustina:

"On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. The soul that will go to Confession [beforehand] and receive Holy Communion [on that day] shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment."

The theologian who examined Saint Faustina's writings for the Holy See, Rev. Ignacy Rozycki, explained that **this is the promise of a complete renewal of baptismal grace,** and in that sense like a "second Baptism."

To obtain the extraordinary graces promised by Our Lord, we must:

- † Follow the ABC's given to us by Jesus through Saint Faustina:
 - **A**sk for His Mercy, sincerely repenting of our sins
 - **B**e merciful to others, through actions, words, and prayers
 - Completely trust in Jesus
- † Go to Confession (during Lent or Easter Week)

On Divine Mercy Sunday:

- * Receive Holy Communion
- † Venerate the Image of The Divine






