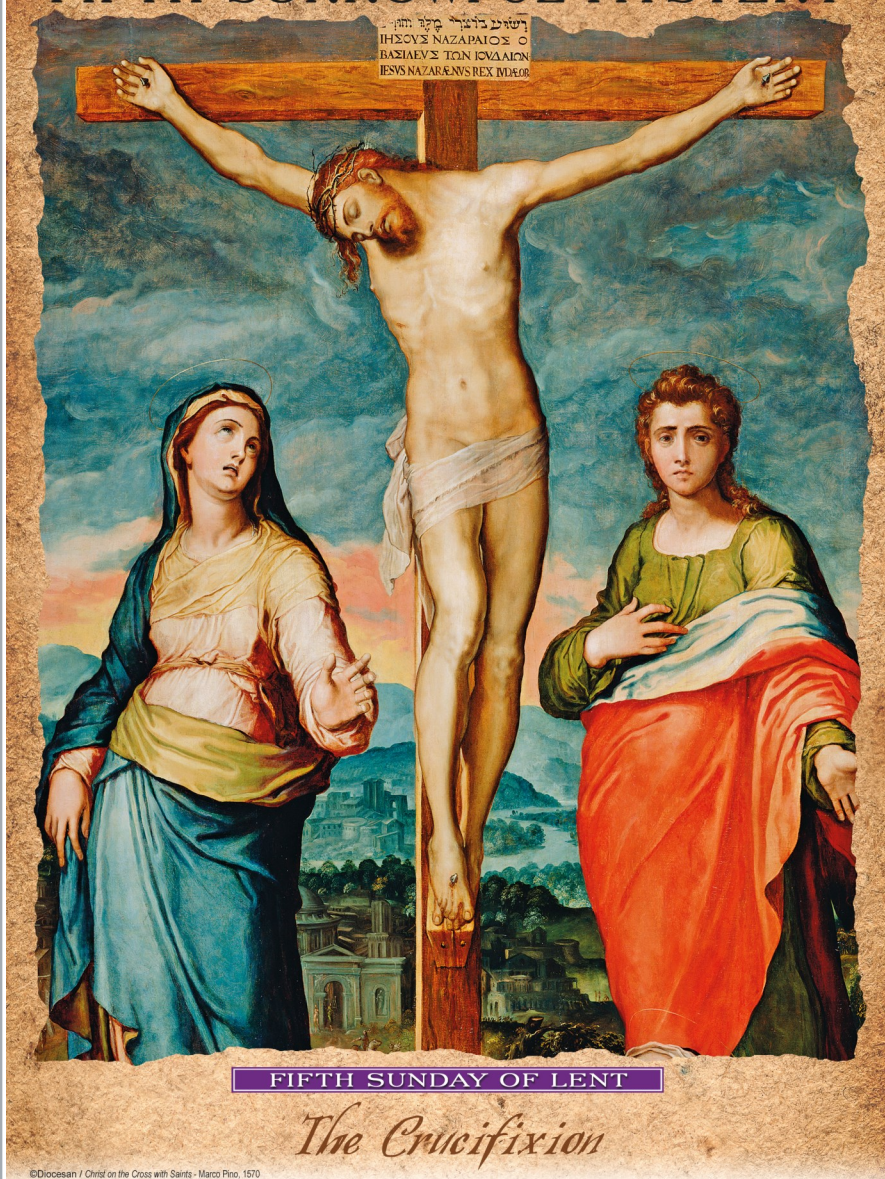

This weekend Father Gabriel Gillen, O.P. is glad to have the opportunity to visit our parish on behalf of Fellowship of Catholic University Students (FOCUS). Father Gabriel serves as a National Chaplain for FOCUS and is assigned to the priory of Saint Dominic in Washington, D.C.

Father Gabriel is a graduate of State University of New York in Stony Brook and worked for several years as a stockbroker on Wall Street. After visiting Medjugorje, he returned to the sacraments and felt a call to the priesthood. He studied in Rome earning degrees from the Angelicum and was ordained in 2000 by John Cardinal Foley in Subiaco, Italy. Prior to his role at FOCUS, he served for ten years as Vicar Provincial for Development for the Province of Saint Joseph to support the record number of vocations to the priesthood. In addition, he has served as the director of the Rosary Shrine of Saint Jude; a college chaplain at New York University; a chaplain at Sloan Kettering Memorial Hospital; and is currently chaplain and honorary member of the Fishers Island Club in New York. FOCUS is a national organization serving college students at more than 216 campus/locations including eight international locations, 23 parish venues and 10 digital expansion campuses. More than 860 FOCUS missionaries invite college students into a relationship with Christ and His Church, while equipping them for a lifetime of Catholic evangelization. Fr. † ST. FAUSTINA'S PRAYER TO BE MERCIFUL

O Lord, I want to be completely transformed into Your mercy and to be Your living reflection. May the greatest of all divine attributes, that of Your unfathomable mercy, pass through my heart and soul to my neighbor.

† **Help me, O Lord**, that my eyes may be merciful, so that I may never suspect or judge from appearances, but look for what is beautiful in my neighbors' souls and come to their rescue.

† **Help me, O Lord**, that my ears may be merciful, so that I may give heed to my neighbors' needs and not be indifferent to their pains and moanings.

† **Help me, O Lord**, that my tongue may be merciful, so that I should never speak negatively of my neighbor, but have a word of comfort and forgiveness for all.

† **Help me, O Lord**, that my hands may be merciful and filled with good deeds, so that I may do only good to my neighbors and take upon myself the more difficult and toilsome tasks.

† **Help me, O Lord**, that my feet may be merciful, so that I may hurry to assist my neighbor, overcoming my own fatigue and weariness.

† **Help me, O Lord**, that my heart may be merciful so that I myself may feel all the sufferings of my neighbor. May Your mercy, O Lord, rest upon me. AMEN. (*Diary*, 163).

The Promise of Divine Mercy

Regarding the Feast of Divine Mercy, Our Lord said to Saint Faustina:

“On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. The soul that will go to Confession [beforehand] and receive Holy Communion [on that day] shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.”

The theologian who examined Saint Faustina’s writings for the Holy See, Rev. Ignacy Rozycki, explained that **this is the promise of a complete renewal of baptismal grace**, and in that sense like a “second Baptism.”

To obtain the extraordinary graces promised by Our Lord, we must:

✠ Follow the ABC’s given to us by Jesus through Saint Faustina:

- Ask for His Mercy, sincerely repenting of our sins
- Be merciful to others, through actions, words, and prayers
- Completely trust in Jesus

✠ Go to Confession (during Lent or Easter Week)

On Divine Mercy Sunday:

- ✠ Receive Holy Communion
- ✠ Venerate the Image of The Divine

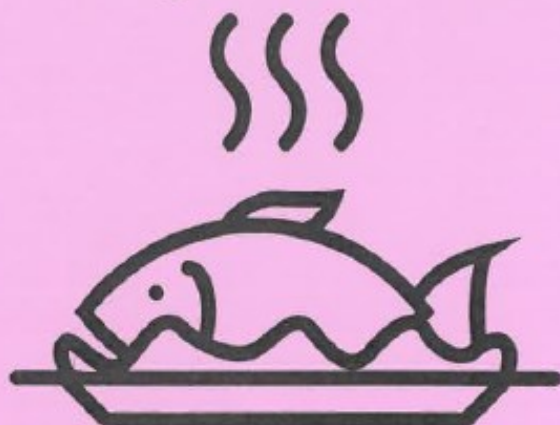

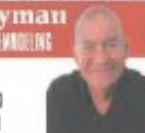
