## Prayer for Intercession of Blessed Stanley Rother for the Healing of Fr. Firmin

April 17th through April 25th, a first class relic of Blessed Stanley Rother will be exposed for veneration and private prayer for the healing of Fr. Firmin.

Blessed Stanley is the first martyr born in the United States and the first U.S. priest to be beatified. Blessed Stanley Rother was an Oklahoma priest killed in Guatemala on July 28, 1981, in his rectory. The Archdiocese of Oklahoma City opened a Cause of Canonization for Blessed Stanley on Oct. 5, 2007.

On December 1, 2016, Pope Francis officially recognized Father Rother as a martyr for the faith. He is the first martyr from the United States and the first U.S.-born priest to be beatified. The Rite of Beatification was held on Sept. 23, 2017, in downtown Oklahoma City — an event attended by more than 20,000 people from around the world.






