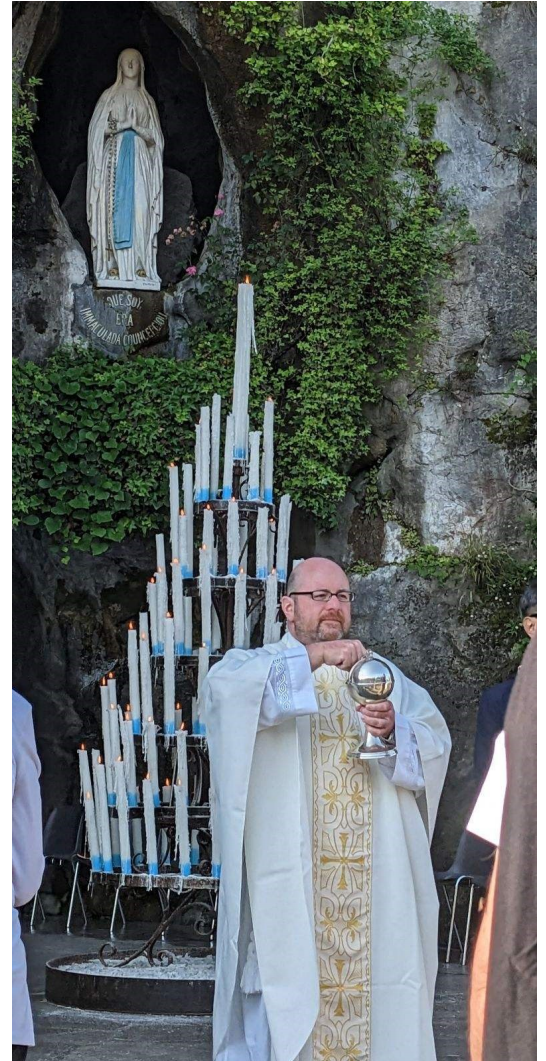
## PASTOR'S CORNER

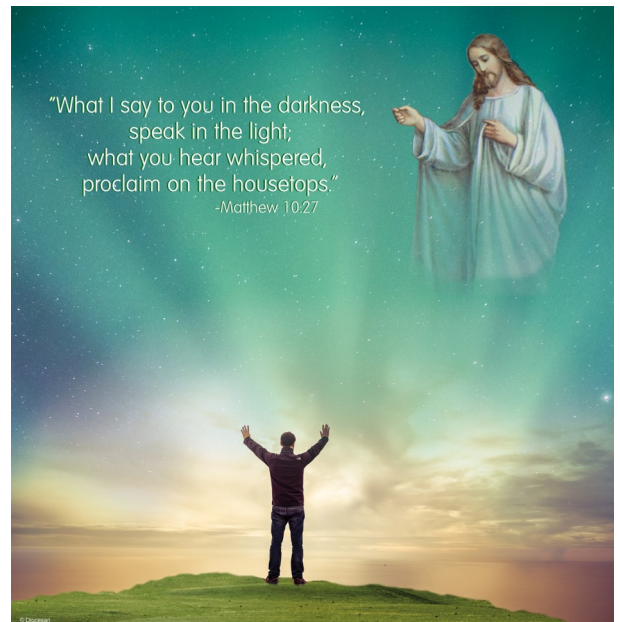
