



Next weekend, a member of the St. James Prison Ministry will update us after each Mass. Through your support, the spirituality outreach for the St James Prison Ministry expanded over this last year. The "pilot" on-site classroom series was completed at the Georgia Coastal State Prison (CSP). We distributed Catholic Bibles, rosaries, religious books, and prayer pamphlets. We supplied basic hygiene products and non-RX reading glasses to those in need. In May, of this year, our prayer group initiated a rosary prayer service at St. James held on the first Friday of each month praying for all impacted by incarceration.

Please continue your assistance is in the form of time, talent, and funds. Your time and talent are needed to attend CSP on-site services, to provide content for the developing prayer pamphlet series, and to participate in the monthly rosary service for the community impacted by incarceration. Funds are needed to refresh the spiritual and educational resources, hygiene products, and reading glasses. We are prayerful and grateful for the talent and funds supporting this ministry.



CCW OF ST. JAMES ANNUAL CHRISTMAS IN AUGUST

St. James will be participating again this year in Box of Joy for children who live in poor countries by filling boxes with toys and other gifts.
