Mission Speaker: Diocese of Norwich Outreach to Haiti

At Masses on Sept. 23-24, parishioners will hear about the Diocese of Norwich's mission serving the poor of Haiti.

The second collection is dedicated to Outreach to Haiti. Funds support the families in the poverty-stricken area of Christ Roi (Christ the King) and throughout 14 twinned sister parishes in the Archdiocese of Port-au-Prince. Your gifts can help provide medical care, nutrition supplements and food, education scholarships, and initiate small businesses and community development. The mission is working to complete the outfitting of a new building that houses a clinic in Christ Roi.

For 40 years, Outreach has been serving some of God's poorest, faith-filled, and inspiring Catholics. In the values of the Gospel, the mission provides sacramental and spiritual support through programs and relationships with twins in both the US and Haiti.

Marie Farrell has directed this ministry for seven years. She comes to share Christ's mission and invites you to be a part of our diocesan ministry. Our Haitian brothers and sisters are struggling with severe food shortages, political unrest, and the uncertainties we are all facing, but more challenging in Haiti where help and health care is meager. 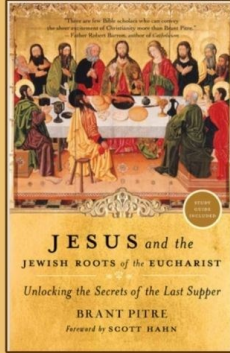

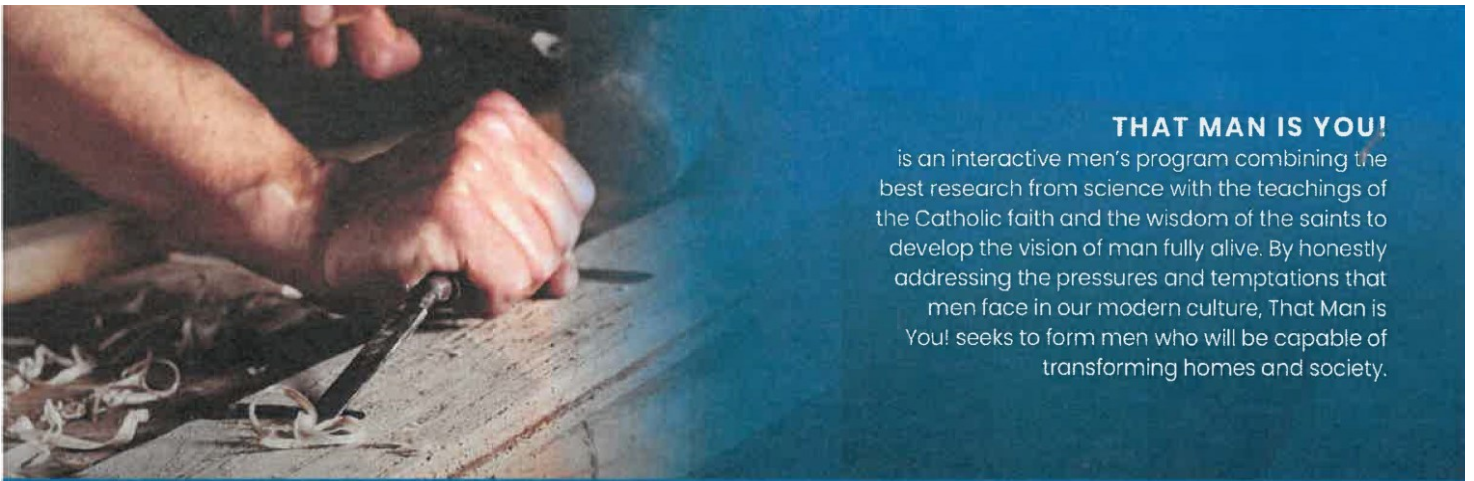
