CHRISTIANS WITH INTEGRITY

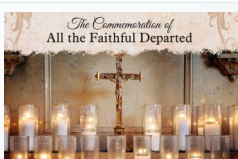

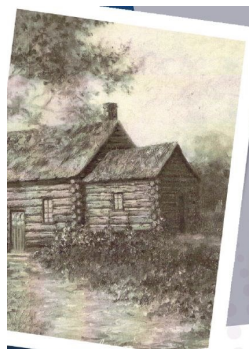
