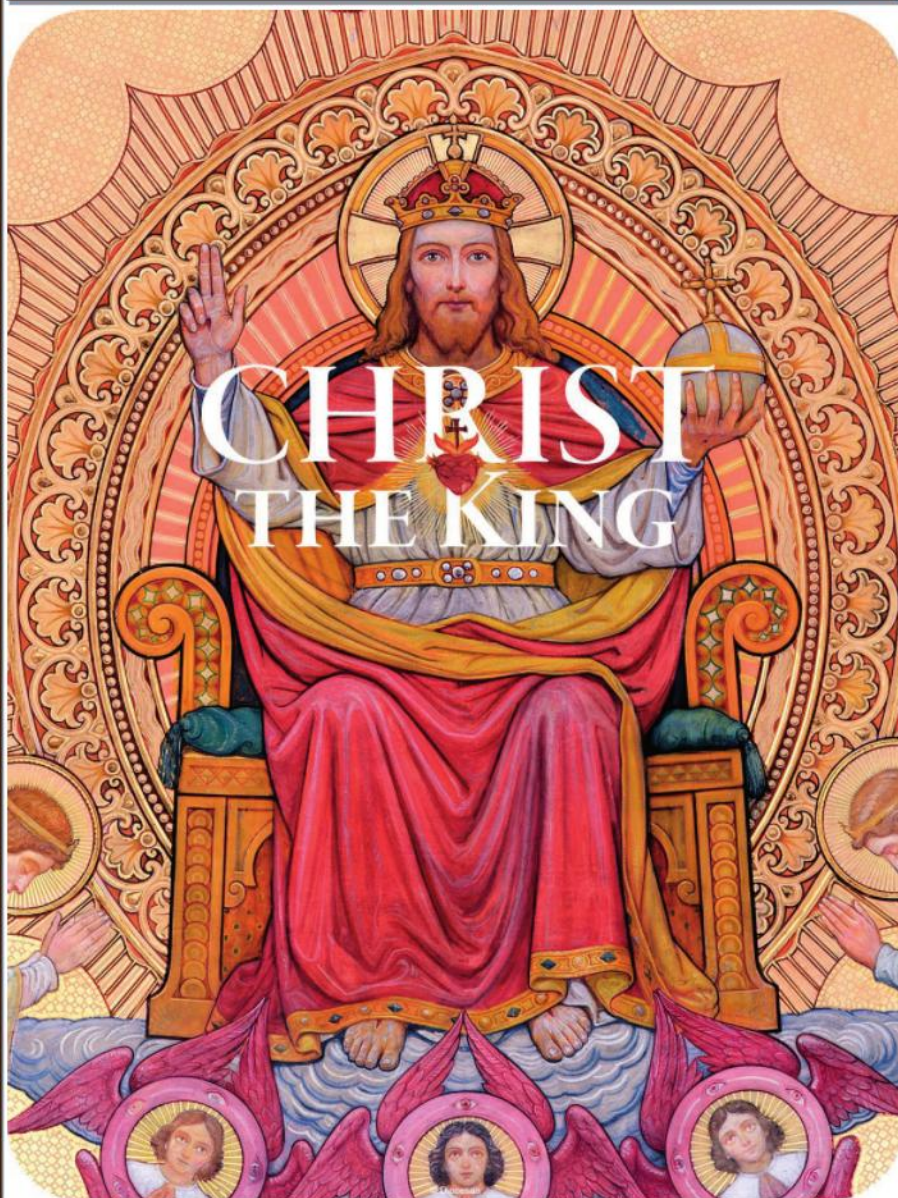

PASTOR'S CORNER

CHRIST THE KING SUNDAY

HAPPY THANKSGIVING!

I hope you and your family had a wonderful and happy Thanksgiving! What a beautiful time of year to stop and give thanks to the Lord for His abundant blessings! Perhaps this year, all of us, as parishioners of St. James the Less, can develop a habit of giving thanks, an attitude of gratitude. What a gift you are to me! I thank the Lord for you often, the people of St. James!

CHRIST THE KING

Only living with this grace of gratitude can we turn and face the world around us! It is a bizarre and crazy world. When we live gratitude, we acknowledge that Jesus Christ is King, the King of the Universe. It is a Christian trait, perhaps the most essential Christian trait, to give thanks and praise in every situation and circumstance. St. Paul writes this to the Thessalonians and to us, "In everything give thanks." No matter the state of the world or our own situations, we give thanks. Why? Because we see with the eyes of Wisdom. We see the Lord Jesus in everything because He reveals Himself in every situation, time, circumstance, glory, tragedy, peace, and pain. He is present there with us. My goodness, this is why we give thanks! How could we do this without Him? He works all things for your salvation, for my salvation, and for the salvation of all. He is the King of Kings, the Lord of Lords, King of the Universe. We are in His hands and nothing can take us out of His hands.

ADVENT

Next Sunday is the first week of Advent! Can you believe that? The days and weeks fly by!

We have decided to decrease our parish activities a bit this year so that we can try to help you and us enter into the season and slow down a bit so that we can prepare for the birth of our Lord Jesus Christ!

Last year, we had the longest Advent we could possibly have. This year Advent is the shortest it could ever be! December 24 is the 4th Sunday of Advent. December 25 is a Monday. So, what does that mean? In order to fulfill your Sunday obligation and receive communion for Christmas, you must come to mass at the Saturday evening Vigil Mass (5:00 PM) or Sunday morning (December 24). We will begin Christmas Masses at 5:00 PM on December 24, Sunday evening. We will have two masses offered at that time and the two masses offered at 8:00 PM. You could also go to mass Sunday morning and then attend mass on Christmas Day, Monday, December 25 at 10:00 AM (one of the most beautiful masses of the year according to me!).

I urge you to begin planning your 4th Sunday of Advent and Christmas mass schedule for your family!

May you and your families know the abundant love of God this week!
