

PASTOR'S CORNER 2ND SUNDAY OF ORDINARY TIME

SCHOOL OF SPIRITUAL DIRECTION

I will be away from St. James for the next two weeks to attend my third and final session at the Alleluia School of Spiritual Direction. The first session was on Prayer. The session July of 2023 was on Healing. This session is on Growth. During these next two weeks, we will be examining the following themes in the spiritual life: detachment, practicing the presence of God, knowing Jesus in a deeper more intimate way, living in faith, hope, and charity, and exercising the gifts of the Holy Spirit. Continuing Education is important for everyone! As a priest, this School has been my continuing education the past few years and my desire is that it helps me be a better pastor and spiritual guide for you and all the people of God.

My desire is to have parishioners trained in spiritual direction so that we can begin a Spiritual Direction ministry here at St. James. We all need someone to accompany us on the journey of discipleship of Jesus Christ. Spiritual Directors assist us in hearing the Lord and discerning what He is doing in and with us and where He might be leading us. Two parishioners will be with me these two weeks to begin their training. It is a 2 year process in which the student attends 3, two week sessions (with graduation at the final session), as well as going on an 8-day Ignatian Retreat, and completing a spiritual direction practicum for 16 weeks.

Please keep the three of us in your prayers these next couple of weeks!

CURSILLO WEEKEND ENCOUNTER


What is Cursillo? Cursillo is a movement of the Catholic Church that makes it possible for people to live what is fundamental to being a Catholic




