



Our Lady of Good Hope Chapel 150th Anniversary


Our Lady of Good Hope Chapel, located on the Isle of Hope, will celebrate its 150th anniversary in May 2024.

MEN'S EXODUS LENT PROGRAM





RCIA Update: Scrutiny Rites for the Elect

Beginning this weekend and continuing for the next three weeks, our parish family will celebrate the Scrutiny Rites with the Elect. The Elect are those among us who are preparing to be baptized at Easter. As part of their final preparation for the sacraments, special prayers are offered for the Elect that they will have the help of God in their fight against sin in their lives, and the grace to respond to God's invitation to new life through baptism. The First Scrutiny will be celebrated Saturday, March 2 at 5 p.m. Mass. The Second Scrutiny will be celebrated Sunday, March 10 at 9 a.m. Mass, and the Third Scrutiny will be celebrated Sunday, March 17 at 11:30 a.m. Mass.

At the conclusion of each Scrutiny, the Elect are dismissed from Mass for a time of reflection on the Sunday Gospel. The dismissal of the Elect highlights for them that they are not yet able to fully participate in the celebration of the Eucharist and helps them develop a longing and an expectation for the day when they will join us all around the Eucharistic table. The Candidates – those already baptized Christians seeking full communion with the Catholic Church – join them in this time of reflection and preparation.
