

The Promise of Divine Mercy

Regarding the Feast of Divine Mercy, Our Lord said to Saint Faustina:

“On that day the very depths of my tender mercy are open. The soul that will go to Confession [beforehand] and receive Holy Communion [on that day] shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment.”

The theologian who examined Saint Faustina’s writings for the Holy See, Rev. Ignacy Rozycki, explained that this is the promise of **a complete renewal of baptismal grace**, and in that sense like a “second Baptism.”

To obtain the extraordinary graces promised by Our Lord, we must:

✠ Follow the ABC’s given to us by Jesus through Saint Faustina:

Ask for His Mercy, sincerely repenting of our sins
Be merciful to others, through actions, words, and prayers


Completely trust in Jesus

The boat will dock at the Landings Marina where you will be shuttled to the historic site. **The cost is \$25 per person.**

- ◆ Drive your own car to the site located on Priest Landing Drive and Breckenridge Lane. No cost.

If you are driving to the site, please bring your own chair. Drinks & snacks will be provided.

Our Lady of Good Hope Chapel was originally established in 1874 by Benedictine Fathers who came to Savannah to minister to the emancipated slaves. The Benedictine Fathers would row to Isle of Hope from Priest's Landing on Skidaway to celebrate Mass in the chapel for local residents. A portion of the remains of the Benedictine Monastery and the Freedman School can still be seen today on the Landings at Skidaway Island.

DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY (SUNDAY WITHIN THE OCTAVE OF EASTER)

The 2nd Sunday of Easter is known as Divine Mercy Sunday. We remember the mercy of Almighty God poured out for us and we place ourselves under the font of His Love and Mercy! I pray that each of you had a beautiful Easter Octave in which we celebrated each day as if it were Easter again! The *Gloria* is recited at masses. The *Te Deum* is recited during the Matins in the Divine Office (Liturgy of the Hours). Each day we live as if living in the eternal rest of God as we do each Sunday!


